Victoria's rural health professionals honoured in Creswick

The Victorian Rural Health Awards was held for the thirteenth year to recognise the outstanding commitment and dedication of health professionals working in rural Victoria. Twenty five awards were presented to rural doctors, nurses, allied health professionals, practice managers and medical specialists. A gala dinner was held at the Creswick on the 28 April 2018.

The Victorian Rural Health Awards is hosted by the Rural Workforce Agency Victoria (RWAV) and sponsored by the Victorian Department of Health and Human Services. The awards were signed by Hon Daniel Andrews and were presented by Ms Gabrielle Williams MP, Victorian Parliamentary Secretary for Health.

The award recipients have made a significant impact on the health and wellbeing of their local communities. The awards honour exceptional medical specialists, GPs, nurses, Aboriginal health workers, general practices, practice managers, allied health professionals and medical and nursing students working across rural Victoria.

More than 170 guests attended the ceremony representing health service providers, local community leaders, award recipients' friends, colleagues and families.

"We celebrate GPs, rural GP locums and medical specialists, who not only go beyond their call of duty but also support each other and mentor the next generation of health professionals. We value allied health workers, nurses, practice managers, and Aboriginal health workers who provide invaluable support and expertise to build strong healthcare teams. Each of these health professional's collective efforts deliver a high quality and sustainable healthcare system for rural Victoria" said RWAV Chair, Yousuf Ahmad.

Every year nominations are put forward by members of the public, community organisations and local healthcare providers and are assessed by an independent panel of judges. Nominations open in October of each year and RWAV encourages the public to nominate local healthcare professionals who provide vital health services to rural and remote communities.
